We remain committed to accountability, transparency, and impact.

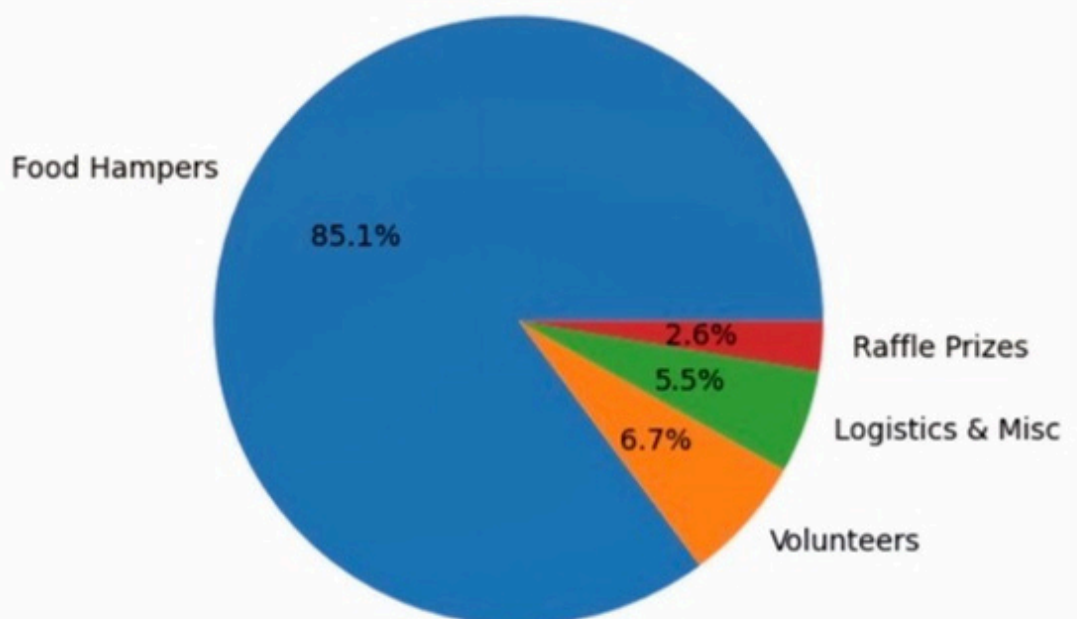
2025 IMPACT SUMMARY

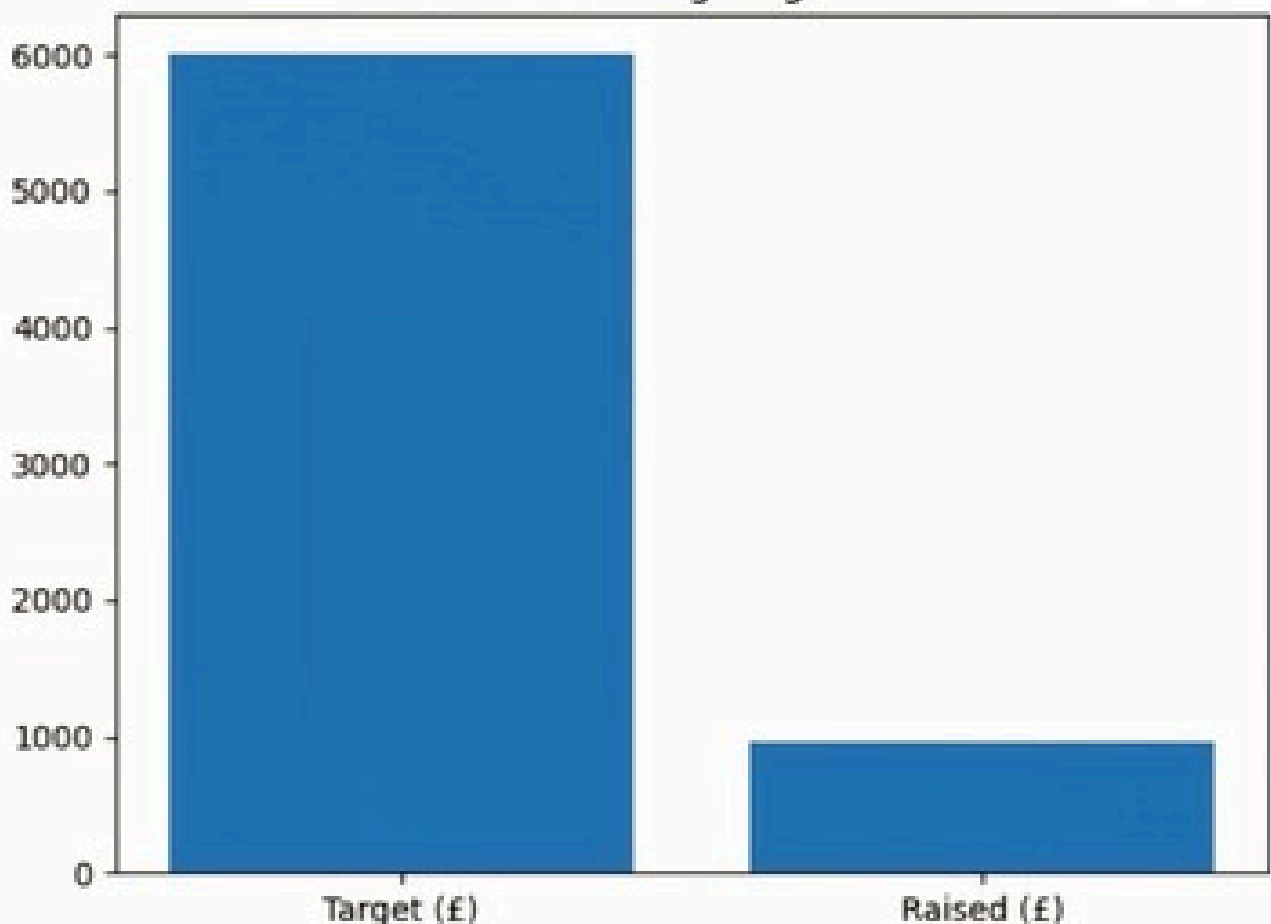

Online Fundraising Target vs Actual

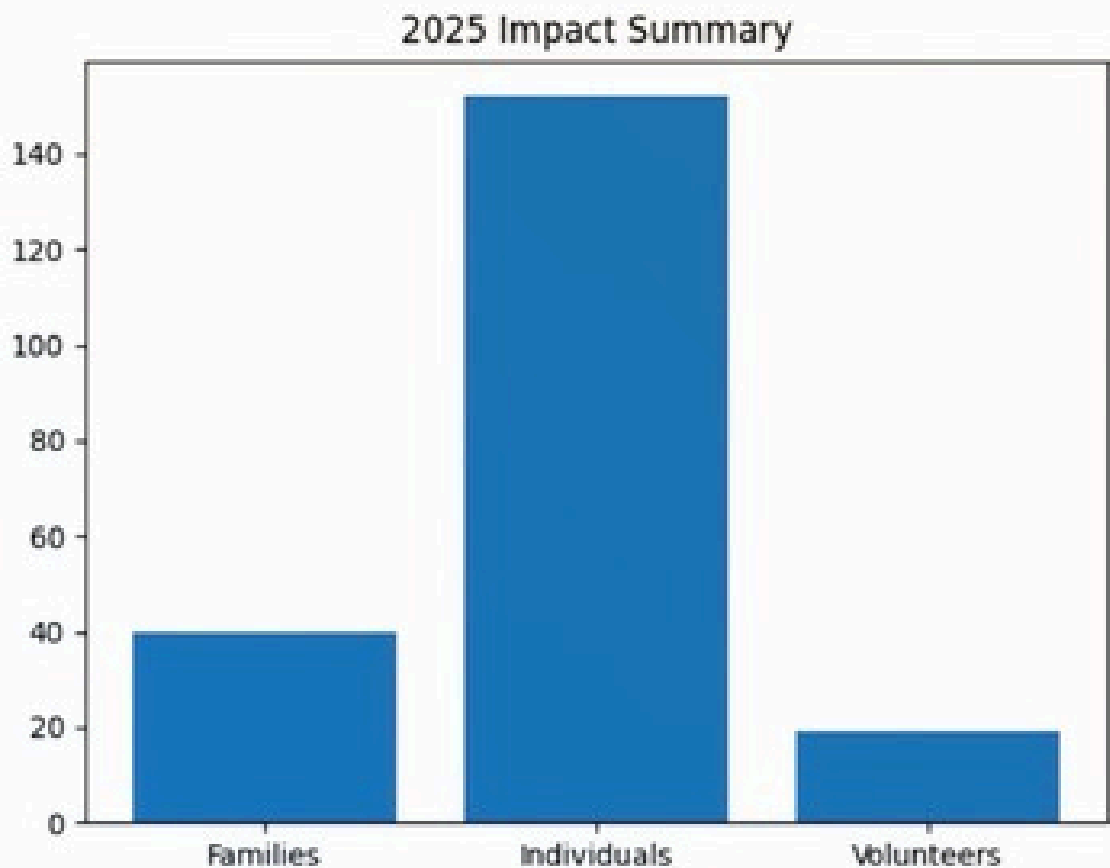

CHRISTMAS HAMPER DISTRIBUTION

We supported **40 families and 152 individuals**.

Each family received a carefully prepared hamper containing:

- 24 essential food items
- Household staples
- Festive provisions



Focus: dignity, relief, and joy during the Christmas season.





VOLUNTEERS

19 volunteers supported the project from start to finish.

Each volunteer received:

- ₦20,000 appreciation support
- A mini Christmas hamper

Their dedication made smooth planning, packing, and distribution possible.

RAFFLE DRAW IMPACT

We also hosted a raffle draw to engage and appreciate supporters.

Winners received:

- ₦100,000
- ₦20,000
- ₦15,000
- ₦10,000
- ₦5,000

Total distributed: **₦150,000**
